### Footnotes

LOYOLA FLYER reluctant to load, last to leave, raced back, improved toward the inside late in the turn as several rivals were parked wide, split foes inside the furlong marker, exhibited good late mettle to be up in time in a game effort. SAINT FLOYD off the early pace while outside, raced four wide into the turn, five wide out, late run to be in time for the place. YES IT'S OK narrowly showed the way early closest to the inside, shook clear in the turn, larger advantage by midstretch, could not contain the top two. CUCOS GONE TO RENO behind the pace inside, enjoyed a good ground saving trip into the stretch, not enough for the win in the late going while continuing inside. FATAL STRIKE pressured the early pace three wide, closest to the leader turn, weakened a bit in the late going. SALTY RIDGE within striking distance well out in the course, four wide into the straight, lacked a late punch. CHICKAWAW CHARLIE void of speed, saved ground through the turn while still well back, steered out for the drive, improved position. HIT THE HIGHWAY brushed start, lacked speed, angled out to six wide out of the turn, little in the way of a late run, finished evenly. THE RIZEN KING brushed at the start, trailed early, passed a couple of tiring foes while never a threat. BATSON raced in mid pack early outside, fanned seven wide out of the turn, tired in the drive. CAPTAIN KEITH fractious while loading, was finished early. WILDCAT RADE vied early, was tiring in traffic when steadied slightly entering the stretch, stopped in the drive.
