**Footnotes**

OUTOFTHEBOX raced in traffic past the wire the first time, settled unhurried off the pace, strong advance on the outside to reach contention late in the second turn, wore down the leader late. E DUBAI fractious in the gate, broke well, angled out nearing the wire the first time, set a quick pace, well clear into the stretch, could not last while drifting out in the late going. QUADROPHONIC SOUND lacked early foot, moved closer along the rail late in the second turn, bit tight upper stretch, moved outside, evenly late. DISCREET HERO forwardly placed, lacked a late response toward the inside. ROYAL SPY raced well out in the strip, called on for some run for the drive, failed to manage any late gain. UNTIL SUNDOWN within contact of the leader early off the rail, weakened through the stretch. RARE CURE pressed the runner up outside that one for just over a half, gave way. WOW bothered a bit in tight quarters the opening quarter, raced forwardly and stopped. SEATTLE NIGHT was never a factor and finished well back.
