STAKES Donnie Wilhite Memorial H. Listed - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$300 to pass the entry box on Wednesday, September 20, and an additional \$400 to start on Saturday, September 23 with \$75,000 Guaranteed of which \$45,000 to the winner, \$15,000 to second, \$7,500 to third, \$3,000 to fourth, \$1,500 to fifth and \$750 each sixth through ninth - with any unpaid monies reverting to the purse account. Weights: Sunday, September 17. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Should this race not be divided and the entry number exceeds the starting gate capacity, high weights will be preferred. Different Owners will have equal draw according to weights. The second part of same Owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Nominations closed Friday, September 15, 2006 with 22 nominees. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 1 1/16 Miles).

KINGSHIP confidently handled behind the first flight and off the inside, moved to the front at will exiting the final turn, quickly clear, kept to task. ELECTRIC CHANT behind the leaders while toward the inside roused for the drive, responded willingly and while no match for the winner in the drive, clearly second best. DANSEUR'S GOLD lacked speed, began a steady advance four wide in the second turn, flattened out a bit in the drive to finish best of the rest. SILENT PLEASURE void of early foot, came four wide into the stretch when set down, managed a mild rally to improve position. RAIN ON MONDAY lacked speed, picked way through some traffic second turn, slipped through along the rail turning for home, finished up evenly. BAMBOO GAP vied early in the four path, shook, clear of the other speed into the far turn, showed the way into the stretch but could not last. COZY TIME three wide trip most of the way, managed little in the way of a rally. MEISQUE PARTY failed to seriously menace. EYE MAN WHO vied up front along the inside, faltered. BALL HALL with the pace while between foes, finished after a half. FOLLOW THE STORM set or forced the pace for a half, gave way.
