LUKEY'S LA TEE DA chased the winner throughout, could do little with that foe in the drive, all out to hold the place. ESPECIALLY SPECIAL within striking distance off the inside, three wide into lane, roused, getting to the runner up late. ANGEL FISH lacked speed, staged a mild rally off the inside. MISS BELL STAR four wide late in the turn, tired in the drive. QUEEN OF THE HEAP forwardly placed briefly, staged a steady retreat before a half. CONDESA EL PRADO lacked a rally. STORMIE BABY wide trip, always outrun. KIT INDY well beaten.
