SUMMANUS settled in the second flight while saving ground, moved out for the drive, challenged the leader with less than a furlong remaining, gained the advantage, held the runner up safe late. TENURE raced in the middle of the pack early, roused for the drive, rallied through traffic and was going well late while outside the winner. WHAT A TRIBUTE away best of all, set or forced the pace along the inside, put the other speed away when straightened for home to garner a larger advantage, weakened in the late going. DIXIE DOT RUN bothered at the start, raced back, improved position, found best stride too late. SASSY MAVERICK turned in an even effort in lacking a late bid. MAC FROM DAKOTA off the pace, raced four wide out of the final turn, made little impact. WITH ATTITUDE showed brief speed while between foes early, began to fall back before a half. ROMAN FOREST vied up front off the inside for six furlongs, tired in the drive while continuing outside. INVISIBLE FORCE off slowly, was never a factor. LA PIANO MAN gave way after a half.
