Footnotes

CONCHOS CHINOS allowed the pace to go early, closer late in the final turn, five wide, moved out, brushed with DOUBLE BIRDIE into the lane, finished with good courage to prove narrowly best. PALM ROAD last away, lacked speed, rallied six wide out of the final turn, finished well to just miss. LEMONY well back off the pace, three path into lane, switched out when straightened for home, closed well. NUBBY DUCKS raced within striking distance throughout, lacked a winning kick. EASY FROM THE GATE four wide in the first turn, evenly paced up the backstretch, four wide into straight, bid a furlong out, hung. BIG CHIEF DEKE contested the issue up front three wide and had little left for the drive. WAR CHIEF fell back to trail after a half, improved

position through the stretch. DOUBLE BIRDIE lacked a rally while five wide into the stretch. SEQUOIA'S CUE failed to respond in the drive. J. B.'S MARQUIS remained always back. CHA BONA vied between foes, gave way. TRUETT'S REBEL narrowly set the pace inside and stopped.
