### Footnotes

FOREIGN GIRL pressured the leader out of the chute while out in the strip, moved up to duel through the turn, roused for the drive, edged away late under continued steady pressure. RAIN TOWN broke sharp, showed the way out of the chute, raced on equal terms with the winner through the turn and into the lane along the inside, gave ground grudgingly to that rival until late, clearly second best. ANOTHER NITTY stumbled at the start, recovered to race within striking distance early, fell back off the top two in the turn and chased that pair home through the stretch to finish up best of the others. KAMARELLA fell back after the start, went one paced throughout and was never dangerous. ART DESIGN moved up while rank to press the early pace, continued unruly the opening quarter, began to fade after a half. PREDESTINED RUNNER was finished early, well beaten.
