SPADRA in the second flight while outside, bit closer three wide late in the turn, engaged the leaders from the outside with a furlong to run and wore them down. PRIMARILY PAYTON moved up to set the pace, vied through the turn while off the inside, could not match strides with the winner late. ROBINETTA chased the runner up early, moved up inside to duel through the turn, weakened in the drive. K J AND A HALF went evenly paced throughout in the two path. VALENTINE SHOES void of early foot, improved position with a mild rally without posing a serious threat. TEXAS BABY BIRD remained back throughout. ILE ST. COURTNEY steadily faded. BEAUTIFUL SHOES settled early, backed up in the drive.
