LUCKY SEVENTEEN dueled up front while closest to the inside, continued to narrowly show the way into the stretch, long drive, brushed, determined. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE STRETCH RUN, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND. STONE SKIPPER dueled up front while outside the winner, heated stretch battle, brushed, outfinished while between foes at the wire. MAJESTIC GENTLEMAN lacked early foot while racing toward the inside, steered out to be widest into the lane, closed with a rush to narrowly miss while widest of the first group. SOFT SHOE settled in the second flight, lacked a closing kick. LANG HEART lacked early foot, steadied in tight quarters late in the final turn, went evenly in the stretch. ETERNAL PURSUIT within striking distance in the early going, came up empty for the drive. MARVELOUS THUNDER off a bit slow, ranged up to be four wide in the second turn, gave way in the drive. GIFTS FOR A KING was finished early.
