PLAYGROUND allowed the pace to go early, advanced and challenged three wide turning for home, duel late, wore down leader. STONE SKIPPER narrowly set the pace, headed second turn, continued to vie along the inside, proved stubborn to the end. PRISCILLA'S BOY void of early foot, continued to trail into the far turn while saving ground, angled out for room to be four wide into the stretch, rallied and was up for the show. DALAINEY'S FRIEND set or forced the pace, vied between foes stretch, gave way in the late going. SAINT RAYMOND behind the first flight into the stretch, lacked a late bid. CAT'S CAUSEWAY vied four wide through the first turn, continued to force the issue from the outside, gave way in the drive. WINE CLASSIC faded after a half, stopped second turn, distanced.
