SIR STAR broke alertly, fell back off the pace off the inside, advanced, four wide challenge into the stretch, quickly clear, driving. LITTLE SHEIK within striking distance, midmove 3w to narrowly show the way into the lane, no match winner, all out for the place. STEELY RAN with the pace along the inside, continued to duel into the lane, also proved no match for the winner, outkicked for the place. LE PRINCE off a bit slowly, moved up slightly, came three wide out of the turn, improved position without posing a serious threat. MADD CAT off the pace, moved a bit closer while five wide and outside the winner late in the turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. CODES DIAMOND forwardly placed, dropped inside, shuffled back a bit midway on the turn, evenly drive. DEHEREADAR off slowly, trailed most of the way, picked off a couple of tiring foes. K ONE FOUR off a bit slow, remained back. TORNADO STORM was never close. MC'S PERFECTPOISON vied early, stopped. SHARIR backed up stretch.
