TIZ A SCHOLAR unhurried for six furlong, moved closer approaching a mild on the outside, took over turning for home, got clear then held sway late under steady handling. WAYSTOGEAUX also well back early, advanced after a mile outside, three wide through the third turn, set down for the drive, slowly getting to the winner late. ANNA'S GLORY lacked speed for ten furlongs, advanced from between rivals turning for home, staged a tepid rally to be along for the show. STILL QUICK forward, gained the advantage, showed the way the middle half mile, could not last. PRIETO JOLIE void of speed, advanced five wide out of the third turn, flattened out a bit in the final furlong. FIEND A BIT closer off the inside after a half, stalked, had little left for the drive. HOWELL PARK lacked a late bid. I'M GOOD TO GO far back for over a mile, came five wide out of the final turn, passed tiring rivals. MARION PONDEROSA was not

a threat. SOUTHERN VALUES showed the way early along the inside, headed before a half, retreated. BETH'S CROSSING mid pace, steadied late on the backstretch the second turn, faded. FINE TROUBLEMAKER closest to the leader early out in the course, took over before a half, stopped when headed before a mile, distanced.
