CATHERINE'S LADY allowed the pace to go, advanced and lodged an outside bid upper stretch, brushed, carried out, narrowly prevailed in game fashion. YES IT'S FRIDAY vied up front while three wide early, garnered a larger advantage in the turn, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker, drifted out, carried winner out, outfinished. TRULY JUDY lacked speed, was six wide late in the turn, lodged a mild rally well out in the strip to finish best of the rest,

no match top two. STORMIN LEAKY forwardly placed early, shuffled back early turn, saved ground into the lane, improved while continuing inside. PROPER ONE hesitated at the start to spot the field a couple of lengths, raced back, altered course in traffic upper stretch, improved position. WAR BONNET five wide into and through the turn, made a small advance into the lane, flattened out. CAJUN DANCING lacked early foot, continued back after a half, displayed a modest amount of late interest after the issue had been decided. WHY GO WEST void of speed, passed tiring rivals. GOLDEN TWINKLE tired after a half. I KAN BOO also backed up through the stretch. YOU GOING LET'S GO vied up front in the early going between foes and stopped. ERMOSA PRINSESA set or forced the pace for a half inside and also stopped.
