SPIRITED AMANDA broke alertly, forced the early pace, three wide bid in the turn, clear stretch, all out to last. VACARRI off the pace, advanced five wide late in the turn, lost some ground to the winner into the stretch, getting to that one in the late going. ANNEJUR with the early pace, held a slight advantage along the inside into the stretch, weakened, held the show. BRAZILIAN MAMA forwardly placed early inside, fell back a bit into the turn, moved out four wide soon after, went evenly through the stretch. WORLD OF GOLD went evenly in lacking a late bid. KENTUCKY RUCKUS five wide late in the turn, lacked a rally through the stretch. DANCIN' DAPHNE tired from early efforts. NINA'S GIRL broke a step slow, remained back while failing to menace. GLORITA vied up front off the inside, stopped in the drive. SAUCY WAYS was finished early, far back.
