Footnotes

TIZNOW hopped at the start, recovered and showed the way past the wire the first time, dueled backstretch off the inside, disposed of the other speed turning for home, and steadily increased advantage while only being shown the whip. COMMENDABLE pressed the winner from the outside, dueled backstretch, could not match strides through the stretch and ducked out just inside the furlong marker, held place. MASS MARKET fell far back early, began to move in the second turn but was left with too much to do. CLEVER BRICK void of early foot, saved ground into the stretch, went evenly to the wire. CHRIS'S BAD BOY chased the top two for six furlongs and had little left the final quarter. WHITE STAR within striking distance for a half, steadily faded and finished far back.
