Footnotes

THE DADDY away with the field, set a modest set of early fractions, headed in the second turn, came back to clear, held on in the late going. A. P. ARROW lacked speed, angled out when roused in upper stretch, finished well to be rapidly getting to the winner while well out in the strip. NOLAN'S CAT well back off the pace, came five wide and closer turning for home, flattened a bit and proved no match for the top two. MILITARY MAJOR tracked the pace in the two path, called on for some run when straightened for home, lacked a winning response. SMOKESCREEN raced four wide and within striking distance most of the way, came up empty in the drive. KILATES KISS a pace factor closest to the inside, put a head in front to garner a brief lead midway on the second turn, faded through the stretch. SILVER HAZE tracked the leaders toward the inside, failed to rally. REAL DANDY trailed much of the way, moved out to be six wide exiting the final turn, did not fire. DESERT BREEZE five wide into the first turn, was finished early in a dull effort. ROYAL SAINT settled off the pace, raced in a bit tight upper stretch, collapsed suddenly soon after and fell.
