### Footnotes

STORM PENNANT settled in the second flight, bit closer second turn in traffic and between foes, in tight, clipped heels turning for home, three wide bid late, just up. HI HO SILVER GHOST also in the second group, moved to challenge when straightened for home, led late, missed between foes. DUBLIN ROAD well clear early, set the pace while rating, vied through the second turn, shook off that challenge and garnered a daylight advantage once again upper straight, responded when challenged again past the furlong marker, proved very stubborn while along the inside at the wire. HAND OVER HAND off slow, continued to race back, roused into the lane, angled out upper stretch, finished willingly well out in the course while too late. GAMMA RAY raced in the second group, saved ground through the second turn, moved out slightly for the drive, came up empty. K D'S BIG MAC broke in to bother GET THE PRIZE, raced back, advanced second turn, came five wide into the stretch, lacked a late kick. SOVEREIGN KEY closest to the leader early, vied into and through much of the second turn, gave way in the drive. MCCARTY CANYON fanned six wide into the stretch, failed to rally. UBETA HOPE also lacked a late bid. LITE FROM HEAVEN four wide in the first turn, not a threat. GET THE PRIZE bothered at the start, trailed most of the way.
