LAYTON'S WARBONNET settled off the pace and the inside, moved to the fore on the outside second turn, clear when straightened for home, driving. STUTZ'S STAR lacked speed, rallied four wide into the stretch, no match winner, clear for the place. SHOW ME THE HERO within striking distance early, took over before a half, briefly clear second turn, could not last. MAGIC MORA set the early pace, displaced backstretch, weakened. ROYAL MANOR WAY went evenly in lacking a late bid. LIPLOCK trailed much of the way, passed a couple of tiring rivals. ANGELINA DOLL forwardly placed early, retreated. SCHNAPTOWN finished early, far back.
