TORTUGA FLATS tracked the pace along the inside, waited, sight steady nearing the furlong marker, got through, driving. DOENY GHOST far back, made a late rally down the middle of the course, finished willingly and was closing on the winner. RASPBERRY WINE prompted the pace while off the inside, three wide into the stretch, bid a furlong out, had little left in the late going while all out to prevail for the place. SUSIE SNOOKS broke on top, set the pace, allowed the winner the rail when beginning to falter inside the furlong grounds, continued to weaken. CLASSY IDE pressed the pace early while between horses and in hand, weakened. TENSAS STAR within striking distance, was no factor in the drive.
