NEVERSOELEGANT unhurried early, saved ground second turn, slipped through along the rail turning for home, moved out and won going away. MADAM ARTEX stalked the pace while off the inside, could not match the winner late, edging away for the place. SMART LITTLE HALO cleared soon after the start, set the pace then vied in the run up the backstretch while firmly in hand, clear again second turn, could not last. B BERRY BRANDY moved a bit closer on the outside in the second turn, crossed to the rail for the drive, finished up evenly. STORMIN MOON failed to make an impact. SHONS A STORMIN moved up outside the early leader to duel backstretch, began to fade second turn. EXECUTIVE VISION remained back throughout. SPIRITUAL POINT forwardly placed for five furlongs off the inside, gave way into the far turn. PINK LEMONADE lunged just prior to the start, lost rider.
