CRAP SHOOTER alternated for the lead closest to the inside, disposed of the other speed nearing the furlong grounds, drew off. YORK AIR (ARG) lacked speed while racing under restraint, rallied through traffic, finished willingly. PISTOL AVENUE enjoyed a rail trip all the way, finished best of the rest. OLE REBEL dueled up front outside the winner, gave way midstretch. HIGH CASCADE made little impact while racing outside. KENTUCKY BAY forwardly placed for a half, faded through the stretch. MAUK FOUR raced wide and failed to threaten. CHEROKEE PROSPECT last away, trailed much of the way. CHOP CHOP stopped, finished far back.
