STAKES Lady Luck S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR TWO YEAR OLD FILLIES. No Nomination Fee. \$200 to pass the entry box on Thursday, October 14 and an additional \$300 to start on Sunday, October 17, with \$50,000 Guaranteed of which \$30,000 to the winner, \$10,000 to second, \$5,000 to third, \$2,500 to fourth, \$1,500 to fifth and \$1,000 to sixth. Weight: 121 lbs. Non winners of a Sweepstakes allowed 3 lbs.; \$6,000 twice allowed 5 lbs.; \$6,000 once allowed 7 lbs. Maidens, allowed 9 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Should this race not be divided and the entry number exceeds the starting gate capacity, high weights will be preferred. Different owners will have equal draw according to weights. The second part of same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Nominations Closed Friday, October 8, 2004 with 25 Nominees. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 1 Mile and 70 Yards) (Rail at 10 feet).

CASH COUNTER allowed to settle off the pace and the inside, came three wide through the second turn, responded when asked soon after, finished well to be in time. READY TO LIVE closest to the leader off the rail, collared that foe into the stretch, got clear but could not contain the winner despite firm handling. TOCHA forward early along the inside, fell back while continuing along the rail, picked up and moved to the far outside for the drive, finished willingly. MAGIC STREAK in traffic turning for home, not enough in the drive, outfinished for the show. KETCHMEWHEREYOUCAN clear early, continued to show the way through a comfortable half mild inside, weakened in the drive. WHERE'S BAILEY last away, raced back, managed little rally. D FINE OKIE within striking distance, gave way in the drive. LEENIE'S DEVIL fell back early, lacked a response in the stretch.
