MEAN DEMAND in the second flight while off the inside, advanced and engaged the leader with less than a furlong remaining, wore that foe down. DUSTY TUNNEL dueled up front while off the inside, disposed of the other speed when straightened for home, could not contain the winner. FILM FORTUNE lacked speed, came four wide when beginning to move late in the turn, staged a rally down the middle of the strip to annex the show. JOE'S MAJESTY well back, also came four wide out of the turn and staged a belated rally to improve significantly. CIRCUMVENT lacked speed, moved a bit closer four wide turning for home, lacked a further bid. HUMBLE SMARTY set or forced the pace for over a half toward the rail, gave way. CURSESANDBLESSINGS forwardly placed for a half, retreated in the stretch. MORETHANAMOUTHFUL tired in the drive. SMART DRESSED GUY lacked a late bid. CAPOTE'S DIAMOND steadily faded. MARK SAFELY backed up. PUTITBACKMICK was well beaten.
