GORGEOUS REPORT, with the pace four wide down the backstretch, shook clear in the turn and was not threatened in the drive to win ridden out. AXE MAGGIE MAE settled off the pace, chased the winner past the furlong marker and narrowly held the place. HIGH HOPES IRISH raced unhurried for for a half, displayed a moderate amount of late energy and was coming late for the place. MITZI'S OATES also lodged a belated bid. SUMMER VOYAGE vied up front three wide into the turn, raced closest to the winner into the stretch and faltered. FIERY DUCHESS came in at the start, was five wide late in the turn and went evenly in the drive. PLEASANT QUEENIE made little impact. HOWDY DO, forward early, gave way. HONOR THE RING, bothered at the start, was four wide in the turn. REGENT PROSPECT never menaced. SNAZZY NAZZY faded. DIVA TECH, crowded back at the start, remained back and was distanced after losing contact with the field.
