


SARAH LANE'S OATES, void of early foot for six furlongs, was asked for some run turning for home and finished full of run through traffic to be in time. COCOA CREEK settled behind the pace and the inside, split foes entering the straight, brushed with MOCHA MOCHA past the furlong marker and was outfinished. VERSHININA stalked the pace, challenged three wide in the second turn, led late but could not contain the top two. MOCHA MOCHA, within striking distance, raced four wide through the second turn, brushed with the runner up then flattened out late. WIFE FOR LIFE, five wide into the stretch, lacked a winning bid. WANDERLING was six wide turning for home. LANYON'S HOPE lacked a significant late response. DUE TO WIN dueled up front for six furlongs and gave way. BOLD AND PEACEFUL raced wide through both turns and tired. ARCTICA lacked room through the entire second turn. KAFAF dueled and tired through traffic. CROOK'S ANGEL lost considerable ground after coming seven wide into the stretch.
