MIMI'S TIZZY clear past the wire the first time, dueled backstretch, shrugged off the other speed in the second turn, dug in through the stretch to prevail. WILD SQUAW allowed the pace to go early off the inside, challenged the winner from the outside nearing the furlong marker, could not get by. DUE TO WIN moved into a striking position toward the inside with a quarter to run, lacked a winning response late. CROOK'S ANGEL far back for six furlongs, swung to the extreme outside for the drive, willingly while too late. SARAH LANE'S OATES saved ground to no avail as she did not fire. MYSIA JO raced three wide, came up empty for the drive. SOUTHERN IVY four wide into the stretch, went evenly to the wire. SHERRY'S CAHILL off a step slow, moved up to duel the middle half, gave way in the drive.
