CHENE ROUGE with the pace from the start while three wide, disposed of the other speed after a half to get well clear in the stretch, lasted. CROSSING PINEY far back early, rallied while off the rail, finished willingly while too late. CODES MISS TEX stalked the pace early off the rail, quick move to challenge in the turn, hung in the drive. LIL MISS CASEY off a bit slow, back early, modest amount of late interest. CODES MISS DOC vied up front for a half and weakened. PISTOLS LAST STAND lacked a late bid. TIMELESS DREAMER with the pace, steadied from between foes into the turn, backed up.
