WILD LUSH was allowed to settle off the pace, waited briefly behind horses turning for home, angled out slightly in upper straight and proved best while fully extended. LADYOTE prompted the pace, continued to vie into the stretch, gained the advantage past the furlong marker and gave ground grudgingly to the winner. LADY ANDOVER allowed the pace to go early, lodged a bold move four wide in the second turn, showed the way into the stretch but could not last. IDEALIST moved closer five wide exiting the final turn then flattened out a bit in the drive. KEYSUNDERTHEMATT lacked a response in the drive. DUSTY TIGER broke slow and made little impact. TIGRIS RIVER lodged a bid into the far turn, put a head in front then faltered in the drive. RAVEN STAR sprinted out to a long lead and gave way when headed in the second turn. ZIP CODE raced far back.
