MIDGE TOO broke on top, set a very modest pace along the inside, plenty left for the drive. HIGH HOPES IRISH pressured the winner from the outside, tried that one late in the second turn, no match, narrowly held the place. DUE TO WIN stalked the pace, set down for the drive, finished willingly to be getting to the runner up. FLEWSY went evenly through the stretch in lacking a late bid. HIJA DE PLATA never menaced while remaining back. DARN THAT DANCER within striking distance for six furlongs, gave way through the stretch.
