GO GIRLFRIEND GO lacked speed while saving ground, waited behind traffic in the second turn while continuing inside, got through along the rail in upper straight under patient handling, finished willingly. SMOKEY DIPLOMACY closest to the leader, took over from that one in the second turn, garnered a larger advantage when straightened for home, could not contain the winner. MRS. DEBBIE M allowed to settle early, moved closer late in the second turn, brushed in upper stretch, did not have enough in the late going. PAMPERED lacked speed, came four wide into the lane, improved position slightly in traffic late. INTRACTABLE void of early foot, swung to the far outside to be widest of all in the drive, some close late. PAD THE WALLET raced back and in traffic second turn and into the lane, split foes nearing the furlong marker, lacked a significant late response. BAENA in the second flight turning for home, bit tight upper stretch, came up empty late. BONITA'S REINBEAU within striking distance while outside, brushed upper stretch, gave way. NO BETTER CHANCE showed the way for six furlongs, faltered when headed.
