MOVING APPEAL moved up rapidly after the start to set the pace, remained clear in the drive while being kept to task. CALLI RIO moved toward the inside, raced forwardly into the lane, could do little with the winner the final furlong, held sway for the place. HANNA'S HARMONY evenly paced outside, no late gain. YES SHE'S SMOOTH off the pace, improved position while racing toward the inside. PRAIRIE three wide, angled out when straightened for home, also improved a bit. TATUM GIRL off slow, moved up, went evenly through the stretch. VAN BULLEIT off a bit slow, trailed early, passed tiring foes. RUBY'S GRAND SLAM prompted the pace for a half and gave way. FOREVER GRACE came five wide out of the turn, failed to rally. CAITLIN'S GRACE broke in, remained always back. EXPECTAWINNER staged a steady retreat. JESSIE'SGOTAFEVER finished far back.
