Footnotes

CABDRIVER AL allowed the pace to go early, advanced steadily the third quarter, angled out a bit for room turning for home, finished willingly to drive well clear. HOLDITTOGETHER forwardly placed, moved up to join the fray three wide in the far turn, proved no match for the winner late, well clear of the rest. SIR RABBIT alternated up front closest to the inside, weakened a bit in the drive, narrowly held the show. PREACHERS LUCK set or forced the pace off the inside, weakened, missed the show. RUSSIAN HUNTER moved a bit closer late in the final turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. CLASS WITH SASS lacked speed, improved position without posing a serious threat. ORLEANDER made little impact. ROCK 'N RAIL lacked speed, passed tiring foes. EARLY BID (GB) off slow, wide in the second turn, no threat in the drive. VICAR'S HERO forwardly placed for six furlongs, faded in the drive. SOLVING PROSPECT tired after a half. TRIPPLE DIAMOND was finished early.
