SLIP AWAY raced near the inside while in contact the leaders, was up with a bid three furlongs from the wire to duel briefly with SUNSHINE NUMBERS, bested that one with a game effort to be well clear at the stretch. SUNSHINE NUMBERS set the pace for mile and a half, dueled briefly with SLIP AWAY when that one drew even nearing the eleventh fence but was empty for the final quarter. FOUR SCHOOLS (IRE) prompted the pace for a mile, gave ground on the second circuit while still in striking position, then lacked a rally in the late going. FREE ADMISSION raced towards the rear most way and never menaced. CUSE bolted a bit at the start, was outrun early while showing mild interest midway. MARK THE SHARK tired early.
