FRA DIAVOLO (ARG) was well placed along the rail behind the leader, had a strong bid approaching the top of the stretch and finished strong under mild urging. MEADOW LARKING was always up close had a bid three furlongs out to take a brief lead then was outfinished. STREAKING PRINCESS raced in good position in the early stages, then lacked a response late to finish evenly. ADVENTURA raced near mid pack while unhurried, made a move on the outside nearing the top of the lane but flattened out. WON WILD BIRD showed a good early foot to set the pace for the second flight, raced near the inside but lacked the needed response late. BERANI was never a threat. RON GRESCHNER raced outside and was not a factor. MUST BE ST. NICK was outrun. BK'S DOUBLE JADE was rank in the opening half while setting the pace, tired and pulled up. LA RESISTANCE was four wide early, was never close and pulled up. RUN UP THE FLAG tracked the pace in the early going, tired after a mile and half and pulled up. PREP SCHOOL raced five wide on the first circuit, was through early and pulled up. ALL RACES AT THE HIGH HOPE STEEPLECHASE ARE HAND TIMED.
