HUMDINGER pressed the pace on the first circuit, asked for a run near the mid point and responded well to draw even with MECKLENBURG, dueled with that one for a furlong, lost ground to that one jumping the last fence then closed in a rush to be up in time. MECKLENBURG was in front from the early going with mild pressure from HUMDINGER, matched strides with that one to the lane, regained a slight advantage when HUMDINGER lost ground jumping the last and was caught at the wire. CLASS REAL ROCK steadied at the second fence and raced towards the rear, found his best stride in the late going but was not enough. HIGHCREST was not a threat. KATIE'S PRINCE (IRE) was always in contention racing on the outside, hit the twelfth fence and fell.
