Footnotes

AT A BOY RUSS made the pace from inside rivals while pressured, kicked well clear into the lane then was roused lightly while drawing off. BLACK BEAR BILLY stalked the pace from two or three wide then moved up through the lane but could not menace the winner. STARSOVERPARADISE steadied from along the rail into the first turn, continued to save ground and moved up into the lane but could not threaten. BEN WON'T TELL contested the pace from outside the winner to the far turn and weakened. RESONATE stalked the pace from four wide and weakened. OKIE THUNDER moved up inside. MISTER QUIGLEY showed speed from between rivals then steadied off heels leaving the first turn and tired. I'M CATTY was not a threat. REDDER was always back. MFAZI was no factor.
