Footnotes

POWER SWEEP LEFT showed good early speed, raced along the inside and drew off in the final stages under steady pressure. BENJAMIN E. stalked the pace, moved up three wide into the upper stretch and finished second best. CLUEMASTER pressed the pace while racing just off the inside and weakened a bit in the drive. EWING TIGER dropped back early, moved up three wide at the eighth pole and never was a factor. TRANSEPT'S AFFAIR stalked the pace from the inside and weakened a bit in the drive. MAGNIFICENT BLUFF was slow early, raced four wide into the upper stretch and never menaced. MR. MCGAUNASH failed to menace.
