Footnotes

RED ROCK BLUFF set all the pace and drew off to be well clear under a steady hand ride. BOLD ROAR stalked the pace, raced three wide and finished second best. CHERISHISTHEWORD stalked the pace, saved ground and had no final winning bid. NEW NUMBER was unhurried early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and made a mild late gain. BEGG'S stalked the pace along the inside and weakened a bit in the stretch. BAD BIG AL dropped back early, raced four through the far turn into the upper stretch and had no response. VALID THIEF failed to respond. FIVE ALARM showed little. BUMPER was hustled along from the outside and tired readily. SKWHIRL raced six wide in the lane and trailed throughout.
