BLUE LION was allowed to settle early, moved up four wide at the eighth pole and drove clear in the final stages. OSCEOLA LIGHTNING showed good early speed from the outside, raced a bit wide around the first turn, raced four wide down the backstretch through the far turn and was no match for the winner in the latter stages. CAPTAIN BUCKY dropped back early, moved up four wide in the lane and finished willingly to the wire. PRIME REALESTATE stalked the pace, moved up along the inside to challenge entering the far turn and weakened in the drive. FIRE UP THE BELL was slow early, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and never was a serious threat. FORTY BELOW was checked at the start, raced towards the inside and never was a factor. SHILOH'S PAC BOOM stalked the pace along the inside and tired. MINER BIRD pressed the pace and gave way. ROARING MAX failed to sustain a bid.
