BELOIT KAN set all the pace and held gamely to be clear under strong pressure. BRAVE FINALE was allowed to settle early, raced along the inside and finished second best. THE NUTZ was shuffled back at the start, raced three wide and gained ground in the final stages. WILD RANSOM stalked the pace, raced three wide and had no late gain. DRIVEN WEST was bumped at the start, raced towards the inside and had no late winning bid. FISHER COUNTY broke in, pressed the pace and faded the final eighth of a mile. SHIFTY DUDE failed to sustain a bid. SKEECAT failed to menace.
