MISS HICKORY pressed the pace, moved up three wide to challenge into the upper stretch and finished gamely to be clear in the final stages under strong encouragement. KEYSONG set all the pace along the inside but couldn't hold off the winner in the final stages. DRINKININTHEROOM stalked the pace, raced four deep in the lane and finished willingly to the wire. KISS GONE WILD was slow early, raced three wide and had no late winning bid. GRAND ON AFFAIR stalked the leaders, moved up five wide in the lane and never was a serious threat. JAYEMBRO raced four wide and never threatened. FRIDAYNITE IN BOYD saved ground throughout and was always back. MOVER showed little. JESSE TAVIN was outrun.
