Footnotes

AMA MISSPRINT showed good speed from along the inside while pressed by MISTRICK, dug in gamely through the lane and held that one safe in the closing jumps. MISTRICK pressed the pace outside the winner, continued on gamely in the lane and was closing but could not get by the winner. AHEAD OF THE PACK was five wide into the first turn while showing speed, settled back to track the top pair from three and four wide then could not match strides in the lane. SHAWKLIT PREMIERE stalked the pace from three wide and could not close in the lane. J J ZAR saved ground to the backstretch, angled four wide on the far turn and moved up while not a serious threat. KAJIE WON angled to the inside going to the far turn but lacked a rally. LARENS BID stalked the pace racing out from the rail and weakened. MAKINGTHEGRADE was not a factor racing three wide. DABNEY saved ground and was not a factor. FROSTY NAILS tired from four wide.
