CITY LAKE set all the pace, built a long lead and was well clear under steady pressure. HANG ON HENRY was unhurried early, moved up four wide at the eighth pole and was no match for the winner. MATT N MITCH was slow early, raced six wide into the upper stretch and made a good late gain. FIVE OCLOCK SHADOW raced four deep and never was a serious threat. LEAVIN EVEN raced four wide and never was a factor. MINIMAL RISK pressed the pace and gave way. HEARTS ABLAZIN failed to sustain a bid. BAH SHERT stalked the pace and tired. C O RINGO raced far back and was pulled up in the stretch, CO Ringo walked off the track.
