STORMS OF LIFE showed good speed to establish position out from the rail, shook off a bid into the far turn to edge clear nearing the stretch and held safe under steady handling. DANNY SEZ bumped with a rival at the break then steadied as another came outward, moved outside to bid three wide into the far turn then could not run down the winner in the drive. BLAKE RATTLENROLL tracked the pace to bid inside the winner going to the far turn, steadied and awaited room briefly then could not produce the needed late response. JUSTABIT SHAWKLIT was in good position racing three and four wide but lacked a final closing response. POWER SWEEP LEFT bumped with a rival at the start, moved along the inside but lacked a solid closing response. THE BATISTA BOMB floated inward then shied back out from a rival after the break, tracked the early pace from outside the winner and tired.
