DIAMOND DID IT set all the pace and held gamely to be clear under all out pressure. CONSUMERS YUZUMER was unhurried early, moved up four wide at the eighth pole and gained ground gamely in the final stages. PROSPECTORS ALYCAT pressed the pace from the outside, raced four wide in the lane and weakened a bit in the final stages. LYNAE DAWN was allowed to settle early, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and never was a serious threat. KISS GONE WILD pressed the pace and tired. ANNADACIOUS was outrun.
