GENUINE AFFAIR showed the most early speed to establish the pace racing out from the rail, opened a wide lead heading up the backstretch that held to upper stretch then was shortening up in the closing sixteenth to narrowly last. BABY CLAM moved three and four wide in the far turn to rally and take aim at the winner, continued to close on that one through the lane but was also shortening up to last for second. BLACK AND FANCY rallied outside, swung six wide for the drive and finished with good energy to be quickly closing on the top pair. MY FLICKA saved ground to rally through the far turn into the lane and closed well. RUNSANDYRUN broke into the side of the gate, stalked the pace from outside for a half, moved inside going to the far turn but lacked a closing response. BOUND TO LOVER chased the early pace while three to four wide and weakened. SANDY THE SHOE GAL was not a factor. BIG BAD BUNNY lacked a rally racing along the inside.
