CHAMPANGEFORTWO pressed the pace, moved up three wide through the far turn into the upper stretch and finished gamely to edge clear in the final stages under all out pressure. MISS TAGGART was quick to begin, set all the pace along the inside and finished second best. T JAYS AFFAIR was allowed to settle early, moved up four wide at the eighth pole and had no late winning bid. GIBSON CRYSTAL was shuffled back at the start, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and made a mild late rally. SPICE SWIRL stalked the pace, raced three deep and weakened a bit in the drive. ZENA'S AFFAIR stalked the pace along the inside and tired. C O BARQUEEN was slow early and never menaced. SOOKIE'S KOOKIES failed to sustain a bid.
