NERVY was allowed to settle early, moved up three wide and finished gamely to be clear under all out pressure. FLYING LEATHERNECK was forced to take up at the nine sixteenths pole, moved up five wide at the eighth pole and closed in gamely in the final stages. ILE ST. FRANCES drifted around the first turn, lacked room just past the quarter pole and finished willingly in the final stages. PRIMAL ROCK showed good speed along the inside and weakened a bit in the lane. WERRABRAVECYCLONE was unhurried early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and had no late winning bid. DOUGLAS EXPRESS was slow early and never menaced. COOL CRYPTO pressed the pace and tired. PAJAMIANO was hustled along and tired. SLEEK RIDGE failed to sustain a bid.
