MOON OVER MOCHA was bumped at the start, set all the pace and held gamely to be clear under strong pressure. CLUEMASTER was bumped at the start, hustled from the inside to press and finished second best. SWEET WILLIE BROWN was slow early, saved ground throughout and made a mild late gain. ERNIES DELIGHT was slow early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and never was a serious threat. THETOTALPACKAGE raced four deep and never was a factor. RYAN'S WAY pressed the pace from the outside and weakened. DAZZLIN JACK showed little. BLUMIN STAR stalked the pace and tired.
