Footnotes

SHARP MOVE stalked the pace, moved up three wide in the stretch and finished gamely to get up under all out pressure. SUPER J R pressed the pace, gained command down the backstretch and finished gamely to just miss. COBLE AVENUE was slow early, moved up six wide into the upper stretch and closed gamely in the final stages. BAD BOY AIDAN was bumped at the nine sixteenths pole, moved up along the inside and finished willingly to the wire. SWEETTALK'N JUNIOR settled off the early pace, took up at the quarter pole and never was a serious threat. HUXLEY HALL pressed the pace, raced four wide throughout and weakened in the drive. POWER SWEEP LEFT raced three deep and never menaced. C. O. STORM showed good speed from the inside and gave way. TUSCAN FEVER was forced to take up sharply at the nine sixteenths pole, raced three deep and never threatened. WET FAST failed to menace.
